Re: HB 913 - Requests for Public Records

The First Amendment Foundation writes to express our support for House Bill 913, which will be heard by the House Government Operations subcommittee on Monday, March 8, 2021.

HB 913 prevents an agency from filing a declaratory action to determine the status of the records as exempt or confidential. The declaratory action would be filed by an agency (as plaintiff) against the citizen who initially sought public records (as the defendant). Declaratory actions stall requests and force requestors to pay legal costs to defend their constitutional right of access to records.

Section 119.01(1), F.S. provides a right of access to *any* person. This legislation ensures that records are not limited to individuals with the time and resources to defend a declaratory action brought by the government.
